

# POSTAL SERVICES ACT 2000

## SECTION 11

### NOTICE TO REVOKE LICENCES GRANTED TO VARIOUS POSTAL OPERATORS

**Whereas:**

1. Under section 11 of the Postal Services Act 2000, the Postal Services Commission (“Postcomm”), on various dates (as listed below) granted licences (“the licences”) to the following companies (“the licensees”);

2. Under paragraph 1(a) of schedule 3 to each of the licences, each of the licences may be revoked at any time by Postcomm by not less than the requisite period of notice in

writing given to the relevant licensee if that licensee agrees with Postcomm that its licence should be revoked;

3. Each licensee agreed that its licence should be revoked once a new licence had been issued to it taking into account new licensing arrangements that came in to force on 1 January 2006; and
4. New licences were issued to the licensees in the period December 2005 – February 2006.

**Therefore:**

Postcomm gives notice under paragraph 1 of schedule 3 to each of the licences that each of the licences shall be revoked on the date which is 30 days from the date of this notice.
